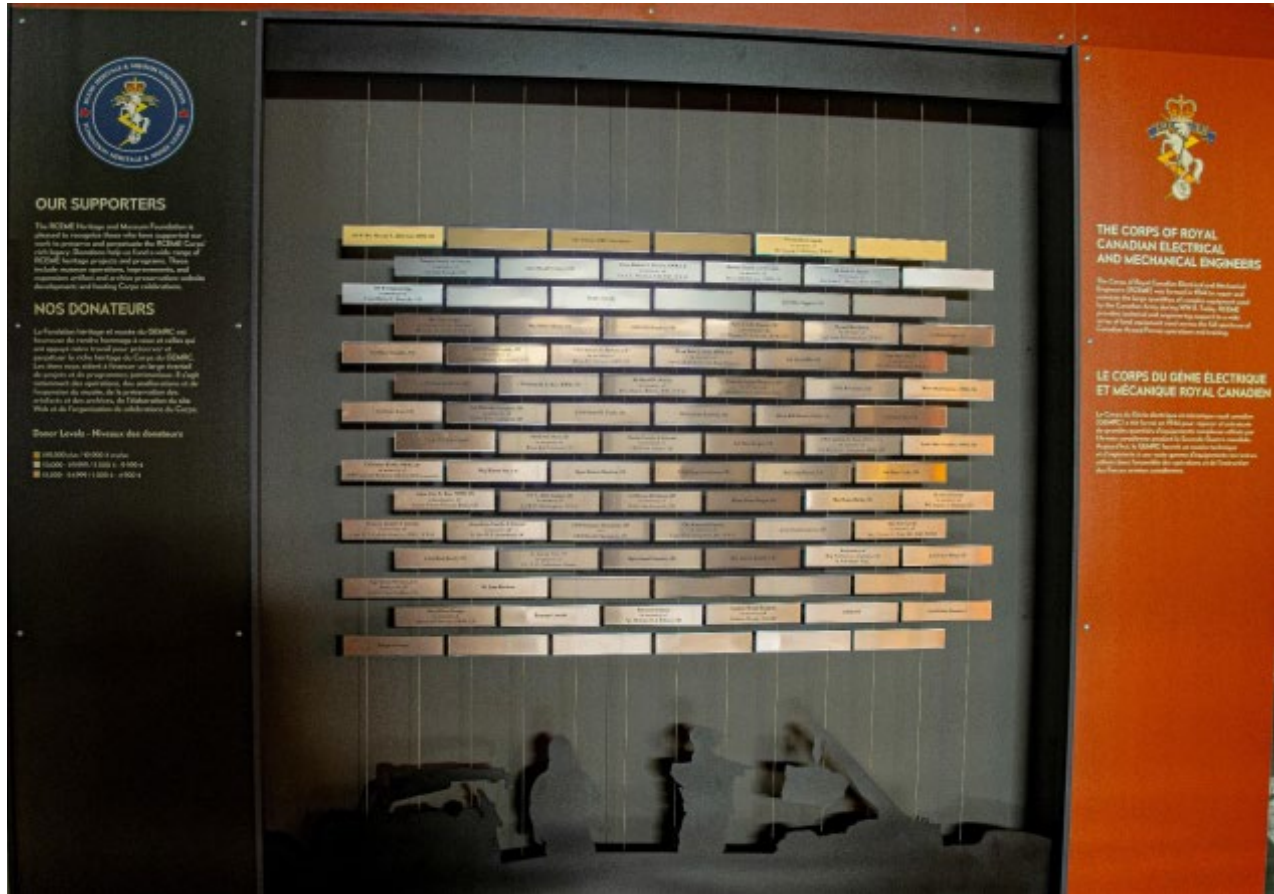


“Sadie” Makes Her Way Across Europe (1944/45)
